
Climate Policy Framework






The Climate Policy Council 15 should evaluate whether the Government's overall policy is compatible with the climate targets established by the Parliament and the Government.

Swedish climate policy has lost steam

Concrete plan for acheiveing the 2030 targets and provide conditions for zero emissions in 2045

Take advantage of the momentum, utilise synergies and handle conflicts






- 1. Develop a climate policy action plan so that the targets for 2030 are achieved
- Ensure that the action plan covers all sectors, and provides an overall policy to reach the long-term target of net-zero emissions by 2045
- 3. Prioritise and coordinate implementation of the action plan under the leadership of the prime minister
- 4. Follow up the implementation of the action plan in the annual climate report to Parliament
- 5. Give standing mandate to agencies to provide decision guidance with proposals that provide emission reductions exceeding targets



Synergies & conflicts: Two cases

Handling increasing energy prices - longterm goals versus shortterm crisis management

The low-carbon industrial transition makes synergies and conflicts more visible



- 6. Reduce vulnerability to future price shocks
- 7. Build skills and preparedness to design crises interventions

that do not counteract the acheivement of long-term goals

- 8. Develop planning processes and forms of collaboration
 - leverage synergies and handle conflicts
- 9. Carry out a review of relevant societal goals and their relation to the climate targets
